Safety Management Systems Essentials

January 11-15 2010

This course is at the center of the SMS training. It's a required course for the SMS Certificate and lays the foundation for an effective SMS program. As of 2009, all member states of ICAO and all aviation service providers within those states must implement a safety management system that as a minimum:

- 1- Identifies safety hazards
- 2- Ensures the implementation of remedial action necessary to maintain safety performance
- 3- Provides continuous monitoring and regular assessment of the safety performance
- 4- Seeks continuous improvement in the overall performance of the safety management system

This course addresses all the ins and outs of facilitating these requirements and is led by an instructor with direct international experience in doing so.

Benefits of this course include:

- Learn the ten basic SMS components required for an effective SMS Risk control Process
- Learn how to take account of human and organizational factors when organizing (or reorganizing) for a SMS
- Special presentation on web-based system which catalogues safety related events and collaborates SMS professionals to effectively take action

Safety Management Systems Workshop

January 18-22 2010

This course puts the theories learned from international Safety Management Systems professionals into practice giving students an opportunity to try different approaches to see what works before investing in an actual program. It is 1 of 4 required courses for the SMS certificate and assumes that attendees already have an understanding of SMS essentials or work with an existing SMS program in place at their facility already. This workshop allows for custom tailored programs to be created under the supervision and guidance of seasoned SMS experts.

This workshop is updated with any changes in regulations and now includes dissection of [FAA Circular AC 120-92](#) and navigating the FAA Preliminary Air Carrier Gap Analysis Tool (7-15-09). In addition to hands on practice in planning and developing their own SMS, all attendees will receive a set of very useful checklists, guides and other tools that can be used to make their SMS a "world class" program.

- Practice developing or using checklists to develop the elements of a safety management system in your own organization
- Develop safety budgets and preparing the financial requirements for an SMS in a format for line managers
