MEETING INDUSTRY NEEDS

Operating in continual improvement mode, SCSI has recently made some changes to the core course curriculum for the SMS Certificate Program. To meet industry needs and give our students maximum flexibility in designing the training program that best matches their professional and operational goals, we've incorporated the SMS Assessment Tool into the SMS-Complete course, and reduced the number of Core (Required) Courses in the program to one—the SMS Complete course. All remaining five courses in the program can be hand-selected by each student as 'Electives', based on their unique individual training needs.

SMS-C:

The Safety Management Systems-Complete (SMS-C) course allows for custom tailored programs to be created under the supervision and guidance of seasoned SMS experts.

The course is updated with any changes in regulations and now includes dissection of [FAA Circular AC 120-92](#) and navigating the FAA Preliminary Air Carrier Gap Analysis Tool (7-15-09). In addition to hands on practice in planning and developing their own SMS, all attendees will receive a set of very useful checklists, guides and other tools that can be used to make their SMS a "world class" program.

SMS-Assessment Tool:

The Safety Management Systems Complete Course Now Includes the SMS Assessment Tool.

The SMS - Assessment Tool is now included in the SMS - Complete course. The Assessment Tool includes a scoring matrix that allows users to quickly detect potential gaps so that they can focus their corrective action on the areas that will have the greatest impact to the operation.
